Albert F. Crumley, MD, 96, of Greenwood, passed away on May 4, 2019. He was born on March 8, 1923, in Topeka, Kansas to the late Frank M. and Grace Ann Mulligan Crumley. Al was a WW II veteran, serving in the Army and later in the Navy. Always interested in medicine, he graduated for medical school and became the Administrator for San Diego County Hospital, a position he held for 15 years.
